**Description:** The full time and/or part time Registered Nurse (RN) will work under the direction of the Medical Director of the OTP Clinic to provide medical care to patients. As a member of the medical staff, the RN will perform health assessments, teach and counsel patients about their health, participate as an integral member of the multidisciplinary treatment team, and execute medical regimens as prescribed by licensed physicians. This will include medication monitoring, observation, inventory, and documentation. The RN will place a strong emphasis on wellness and prevention and help with all aspects of patient care, including diagnosis, treatments and consultations. They will work both independently and as part of an integrated multidisciplinary treatment team; therefore, playing an integral part of patient care and recovery. The RN must possess a strong understanding of addiction medicine and the ability to evaluate the needs of the patient, in order to develop an individualized treatment/recovery plan.

The part time Licensed Practical Nurse (LPN) will work under the direction of the Medical Director of the OTP Clinic to provide medical care to patients to include medication monitoring, observation, inventory, and documentation. The LPN will place a strong emphasis on wellness and prevention and help with all aspects of patient care. They will work both independently and as part of an integrated multidisciplinary treatment team; therefore, playing an integral part of patient care and recovery. The LPN must possess an understanding of addiction medicine and the ability to evaluate the needs of the patient, in order to develop an individualized treatment/recovery plan.

**Minimum Qualifications:**

Must be licensed as a Registered Nurse or Practical Nurse in New York State preferably with experience in the Chemical Dependency and/or Mental Health field

And

Possess a knowledge and understanding of addiction medicine, while supporting the goal of abstinence from mood altering substances unless prescribed by a physician knowledgeable of addiction

And

Must subscribe to a Professional Canon of Ethics.
